SIGN POLICY

Any sign placed on WCPRD properties must be approved by WCPRD Director.

Examples of signs permitted with Director approval:

- WCPRD League-Sponsorship signs
- WCPRD Facility Sponsorship signs
- W.C. Government informational signs
- W.C. Clerk signs, i.e., voting/election informational signs
- Temporary signs for upcoming events on WCPRD properties (must be removed by event group within 24 hours after event)

Examples of signs not permitted and will not be approved:

- Private sponsorship signs
- Realtor signs
- Public event signs
- Yard sale signs,
- Campaign signs

Any signs found on WCPRD properties that are not approved by WCPRD Director will be immediately removed and disposed of, and WCPRD will not reimburse for any removed/disposed of signs.

Special Election Provision: Per the W.C. Attorney's Office, as of November 1, 2022, election campaign signs are not permitted under any circumstances to be placed/put in the ground on any Warren County Properties. However, campaign signs may be **held** by volunteers/workers on Warren County properties if they are at least 100 feet away from the actual voting precinct front door (per State regulations). **Campaign signs may not be left unattended at any time.** Any unattended signs will be immediately removed and disposed of, and WCPRD will not reimburse for any removed/disposed of signs.
